BOLD PREDICTIONS FOR 2018!

Since 2011, home prices are up 48% while wages are only up 15%. Existing home inventory was down 6.4% from 2016. Single family housing starts are projected to increase 9.4% for 2018 but still below the 50 year average. Projection for GDP in 2018 is 2.7% overall growth. (Lawrence Yun, 11/17/2017)

In 2016, first time homebuyers made up 34% of sales, a 5% drop from 2017. We will continue to see a slight down tick in first time homebuyers.

Mortgage interest rates are projected to finish 2018 at 4.5% - 4's are GOOD!

- In Q2, 33 of Oregon's 36 counties had annual job growth; Curry, Morrow & Sherman counties did not -(Office of Economic Analysis, State of Oregon)
- Residential permits in Oregon down 2.5% to September
- Portland permits to September up 7.6%
- United Van Lines South Dakota, Vermont, Oregon, Idaho leading inbound
- In Q2, Oregon personal income up .9% versus U.S. at .7% Strength in Earnings
- Portland congestion 40th in 2016, up from 86th in 2015
